It was announced that the mayor had appointed Mrs. R. Jenkins as a member of the board to take the place of Mrs. Arbuthnot, who had resigned, and the president of the board appointed her a member of the same committees on which Mrs. Arbuthnot had been placed.

It was moved and carried that the librarian's annual report and the financial report of the city treasurer constitute the annual report to the city council.


It was moved and carried that the matter of shelving for the work room and ash cans be referred to the committee on buildings and grounds.

It was announced that Mrs. Manker and Mr. Kusterer had been appointed to succeed themselves on the board and Mrs. R. Jenkins had been appointed to succeed ~~xxxxxxx Harvey~~ ^{and Mrs. Ball} Mrs. Arbuthnot. The Board now stands as follows:
